In this talk, we will present a timeline of Quantitative Literacy (QL) and Quantitative Reasoning (QR) programs, events and publications with the goal of explaining how QL/QR have evolved and matured over the past 25 years. We will give short descriptions of programs that have been in place for over 20 years as well as programs that have just begun, highlight various MAA and NSF activities that have promoted QL/QR interests (including the National Numeracy Network), and comment on publications that have been important in sustaining the QL movement. Participants will have the opportunity to augment a physical timeline (a long, horizontal poster) with post-its that include information about their own programs, events, and/or publications.
